2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.		<p>The following measure were taken to complete syllabus of courses for the MCA program:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Institute created a Registered GSuite account and created Classrooms based on the number of divisions for each year of the MCA Program 2. Students and Faculty members were registered onto these Classrooms and were provided Gmail id to access the classrooms. 3. Conduct of online sessions based on a time table which was suitable for Online delivery from the Teacher's and Student's point of view. The lecture sessions of 1 hour each are conducted on daily basis as per the time table. The time table along with the Academic Calendar are made available online to the students. 4. Student have to access the respective Classroom to attend the Online Lectures. The Attendance of these lectures were recorded automatically through the GSuite Classroom. 5. For every session students were given Online Assignment to be completed and uploaded onto the Online Classrooms (GSuite Classroom) within 24 hours of uploading the Assignment by the Faculty members. 6. Record of submissions was maintained for individual students in the GSuite Classrooms 7. Faculty members assessed the uploaded assignment and also gave Grades and suggestions to the individual students in the classroom 8. Tools such as Quizzes, Polls and Online Presentations were also used to test whether the students have understood the topic or concept properly. 9. SYLLABUS WAS COVERED 100% AND WAS DELIVERED ON TIME WELL BEFORE THE UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS 9. Two Internal Exams were conducted as per the Academic Schedule and as per the norms of the University of Mumbai. These Exams were conducted Online. The Link of the exams was opened exactly as per the timing of the examination and was closed as soon the session of Exam was over. Students were supervised online by keeping the Camera on at their end to discourage mal practices at the exam. 10. Exam pattern had MCQ and Subjective questions. MCQs were provided using Google Forms. Incase of Subjective questions students were required to write the answers and upload the written content by taking a picture of the same and converting it into PDF and uploading it. 11. Results of the Examinations were also declared as per schedule
