# Admission Process for MCA Programme

Thakur Institute of Management Studies, Career Development & Research is a Hindi Linguistic Minority Status Institute having present intake of 240 for MCA program. Out of which 51% of the seats are reserved under Hindi Linguistic Minority category and 20% of the seats are reserved under Institute Level category. The Department of Higher & Technical Education, Govt. of Maharashtra have issued notification for admission process for this program for the academic year 2024-25 through MAH-MCA-CET. The detailed procedure for submission of application for admission to the program will be notified by the State CET cell, ARA and DTE.

Admission to Master of Computer Applications (MCA) Programme is carried out as per the guidelines of Govt. of Maharashtra, State Common Entrance Test Cell, ARA and DTE, Maharashtra State.

(1) For Maharashtra State Candidature Candidates, All India Candidature Candidates, Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir and Union Territory of Ladakh, Migrant Candidature Candidates.

- (i) The candidate should be a citizen of India;
- (ii) Passed any graduation degree (e.g.: B.E. or B.Tech. or B.Sc or B.Com. or B.A. or B. Voc. or BCA etc.); preferably with Mathematics at 10+2 level or at Graduation level and obtained at least fifty per cent marks (at least forty five per cent. in case of candidates of Reserved Categories, Economically Weaker Section and Persons with Disability category belonging to the Maharashtra State) in the qualifying examination;
- (iii) Should have obtained non zero score in MAH-MCA-CET 2024 conducted by the Competent Authority.

(2) NNRI/OCI/PIO, Children of Indian workers in the Gulf countries and Foreign National Candidature Candidates. -

- (i) Passed any graduation degree (e.g.: B.E. or B.Tech. or B.Sc or B.Com. or B.A. or B.Voc. or BCA etc.) preferably with Mathematics at 10+2 level or at Graduation level and obtained at least fifty percent. marks in the qualifying examination;
- (ii) Any other eligibility criteria and requirement declared from time to time by the appropriate authority as defined under the Act.

List of photocopies of Certificates to be submitted:

- MAH-MCA-CET 2024 score card.
- Statement of marks & certificate of SSC, HSC and Graduation (all semester / year).
- Migration and Provisional Passing Certificate for those candidates who passed from any University other than University of Mumbai.
- Certificate of Indian Nationality (School Leaving Certificate indicating the Nationality of the candidate as 'Indian'/ Valid Indian Passport/ Birth Certificate of the candidate indicating the place of birth in India.)
- Domicile Certificate (if applicable), clearly indicating the place of permanent residence of the candidate or father or mother or husband.
- Caste/Tribe Validity Certificate (if applicable)
- Non-Creamy Layer Certificate valid up to 31 March 2025 (if applicable).
- Certificates in Proforma A, B1, B2, C, D, E, G1, G2, J, K, L, M, O, U, V, W1 & W2 as applicable (Mentioned in DTE/CET cell brochure).
- Any other relevant document.

After verification if provisionally confirmed in the Institute, candidate has to submit the following documents.

- All original certificates mentioned above with attested photocopies of the same.
- Affidavit for Minority Status on a ₹ 100/- non judicial stamp paper in institute specified format (only for Linguistic Minority candidates)
- Gap Certificate for the break after completion of Graduation examination on a ₹ 100/- non judicial stamp paper in institute specified format (if applicable).
- AICTE Anti-Ragging undertaking by student as well as parents on ₹ 20/- non-judicial Stamp Paper duly notarized in AICTE specified format.
  - Physical Fitness Certificate from a registered Medical Practitioner.
  - Five recent passport size colour photographs.
  - Any other relevant document.

## Post Graduate Registration & Eligibility

All candidates selected for admission to the Master's Degree Programme are required to register with the University of Mumbai as Post Graduate student.

No candidates will be allowed to pursue any other course of this/any other University simultaneously.

Selection of the candidate for admission to the Master's Degree Programme is provisional and is confirmed only on fulfilment of the following:

- Candidates, graduating from University of Mumbai will be required to produce Transfer Certificate from the college, last attended by them, at the time of admission, if selected.
- Candidates, graduating from other Universities will be required to produce a Provisional Eligibility Certificate issued by the Registrar, University of Mumbai, declaring them eligible for admission to the course. This can be obtained by making an application in the prescribed form and on paying the prescribed fee in cash to the University. Admission will only be confirmed after confirmation of their eligibility by the University.

Finally, Statement of Eligibility required for confirmation of Eligibility should be submitted to the University through the Institute latest by the end of First Semester.

## Accepting/Paying Capitation fee is Strictly Prohibited

In order to ensure transparency in admissions by technical institutions imparting technical education and also in view of the various judgments by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), in exercise of powers conferred under Clause(n) of section 10 of AICTE Act, 1987 (52 of 1987), call upon the students, parents and the general public not to pay any Capitation Fee or any other fee other than that mentioned in the prospectus of the institutions for consideration of admission.

Aggrieved students/parents may send their complaint to the Grievance Redressal Committee of the Institution in the first instance. If they are not satisfied with the decision of the committee, they may send their appeal to the "OMBUDSMAN" (as per AICTE Regulation No. 37-3/Legal/2012 dated 25.5.2012) through Registry appointed by the concerned Institution along with evidence of such payment made to institution.

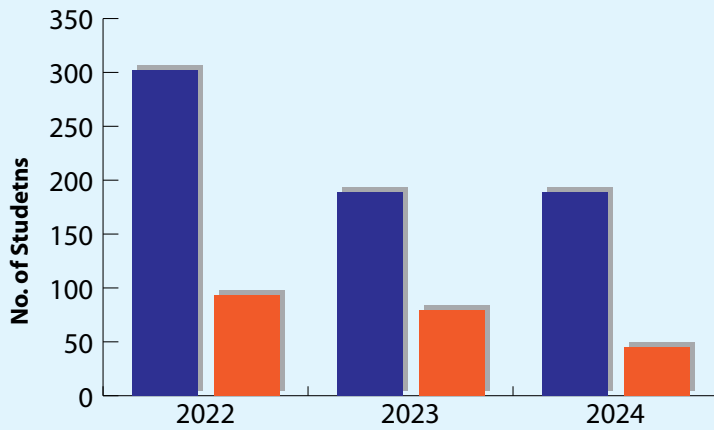


## Placement Process:

3. After clearing all rounds of the Company Interview successfully, company may offer Internship as well as final Placement to the Students.



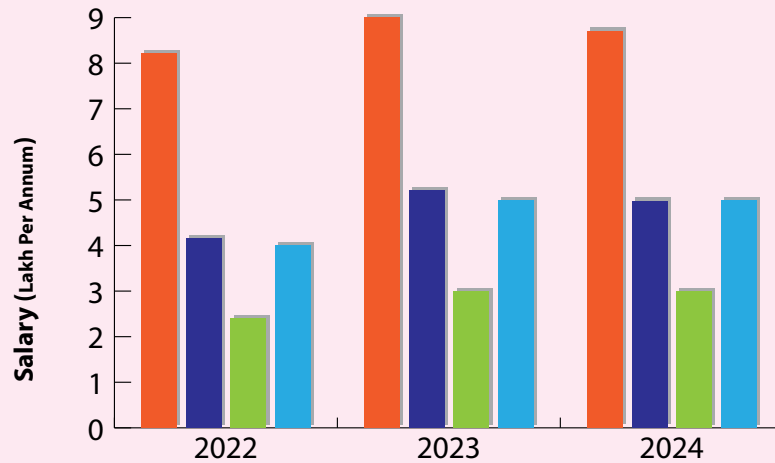
## Placement Graph

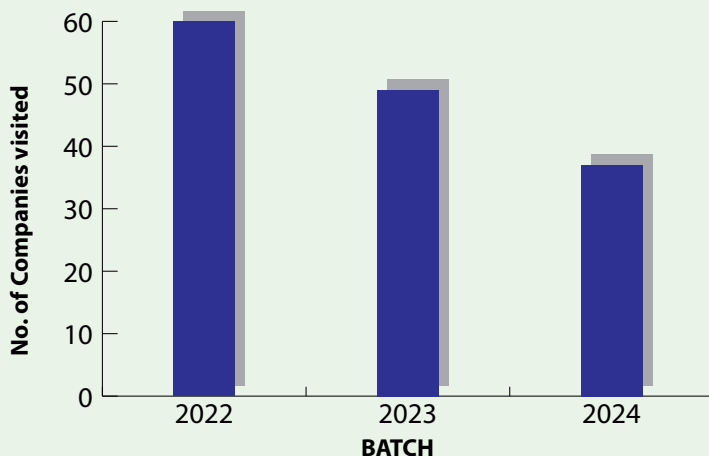
## Salary Graph

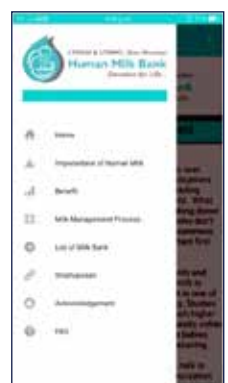

## Code of Conduct for Students

To achieve high ethical and academic standard, students are instructed to follow the Code of Conduct prescribed by the institute

### ACADEMIC CONDUCT

- As a part of academic work, time to time submissions are scheduled for assessment of respective subjects. It is mandatory for the students to follow the schedule and submit the work complete in all respects on time.
- Any research paper/ project/ report submitted by the students has to be original work of the student. Plagiarism shall not be accepted.

### REGULAR ATTENDANCE

- Subject-wise attendance is taken every day. Students should have 75% attendance in all subjects and in developmental programmes like guest lectures, training programs, field visits etc. as per University of Mumbai Ordinance 0.6086.

### GENERAL CONDUCT

- Wearing ID-Card in campus is compulsory.
- Formal and decent dress code should be maintained (half-pants, Capris, three-fourths, are not allowed).
- Only English language shall be used for oral / written communication on campus.
- Students should not talk amongst themselves whenever anyone is addressing the class as a whole. If any students are found disturbing the class with notorious activities, necessary disciplinary action will be taken.
- Loitering in the corridors and making noise on the premises is strictly prohibited.
- Consumption of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, cigarette, and smoking is prohibited in the institute. Students should refrain from visiting smoking joints in the vicinity of the campus.
- Access will not be allowed into lectures, computer labs, seminars after the start of the session. Late comers will be refused entry and should leave immediately, if requested.
- In the event that a student wishes to leave a lecture, seminar or computer lab before its scheduled finish time, the prior permission of the Professor concerned should be obtained except in the case of departure necessitated by reason of illness or other unforeseen circumstances.
- Laptops and other auxiliary aids can be used, in classroom & Labs with permission from the Professor concerned.
- No audio or video recording of any session should take place without the permission of the Professor/ Speaker concerned.

- Food & Beverages shall be consumed only in refreshment room or canteen.
- Misuse or damage to any learning materials including collar mikes, computers, sound systems or LCD Projectors, furniture, fittings, or any other property belonging to the institute will not be tolerated and will lead to disciplinary action, and the entire class will be held responsible for it and shall be liable to pay fine as applicable.
- Seating arrangement in the classroom should not be disturbed.
- Caution Money will be refunded as per the refund policy of the institute.
- Library books and Card should be returned as per the Library policy.
- Comply with all important dates provided by examination section without fail.
- Provide faculty teaching feedback unbiasedly and fearlessly to facilitate positive changes in teaching / training system and help to improve its efficiency and effectiveness.

- **Ragging is prohibited under the Maharashtra State Act of 1999 within or outside of education premises and any act by participant is punishable.**

# Anti-Ragging

## AICTE Notification

As per the notification of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) dated 01.09.2009 in connection with prevention and prohibition of ragging in technical institutions, universities including deemed to be universities imparting technical education, notify that :

“All the concerned persons are requested to make note that ragging is totally banned and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging is liable to be punished.”

## Maharashtra State Act Against Ragging:

Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 which is in effect from 15<sup>th</sup> May 1999 has the following provisions for Action against Ragging:

- Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited.
- Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to 2 years and/ or penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
- Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the education for five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
- Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian of student or a teacher of an educational institution complains, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action. Where on enquiry by the head of the educational institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received; he/she shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the head of the educational institution shall be final.
- If the head of the educational institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in section “d” above when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section “b” above.

The Anti-ragging Committee has been constituted under the chairmanship of the director.

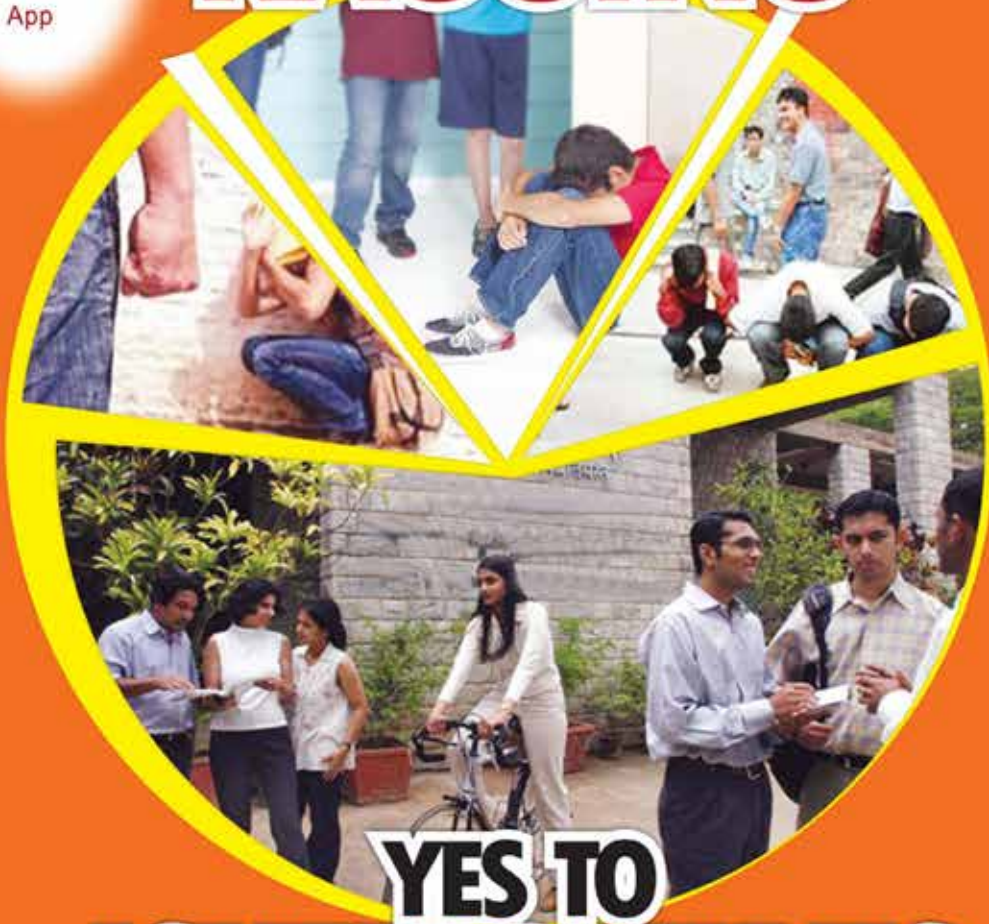

- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament or youth festival etc.
- **Collective punishment** : when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on potential ragger.
